Technical Debt Eraser

USD 15,000 | four-week sprint

For: Software owners and delivery partners with one bounded maintenance backlog.

Reduce a defined maintenance backlog through dependency upgrades, test coverage, defect remediation, build cleanup, and verified code changes inside an approved repository boundary.

- Debt and dependency baseline
- Reviewed code changes with tests
- Verification and residual-risk report

Model-To-Web Converter

USD 12,000 | four-to-six week sprint

For: Research, engineering, advisory, and operations teams with a validated buyer-owned model.

Convert one Excel, VBA, Python, or R model into a tested browser workflow or API while preserving documented logic, assumptions, and approved reference outputs.

- Reference-case reconciliation
- Deployment and handover notes

Synthetic API Lab

USD 10,000 | three-to-five week sprint

For: Product, integration, QA, and enterprise sales teams blocked by unavailable test systems.

Create a bounded synthetic dataset, mock API, or repeatable demo environment from buyer-approved schemas and scenarios without using production personal records.

- Schema and scenario specification
- Synthetic dataset and mock service
- Contract and edge-case tests
- Reset and limitation documentation

Operate and scale delivery

Recurring engineering capacity for teams that need a controlled cadence rather than an unbounded project. Each release remains subject to agreed change, testing, and acceptance rules.

Security Patch Desk

**USD 4,500/month |
12-month term**

For: Software owners or IT delivery firms needing a controlled remediation cadence.

Maintain an agreed application portfolio through vulnerability triage, dependency updates, patch preparation, available tests, release notes, and residual-risk reporting.

- Monthly exposure register
- Approved patch branches or pull requests
- Release and rollback notes
- Quarterly maintenance review

Workflow Automation Retainer

**USD 5,000/month |
12-month term**

For: Operating teams with recurring approvals, data handoffs, spreadsheets, dashboards, or reporting.

Map and improve an agreed workflow portfolio through monthly bounded automation, data cleanup, dashboard, integration, and reporting releases.

White-Label Delivery Support

**USD 7,000/month |
12-month term**

For: IT, ERP, web, engineering, research, and consulting firms needing overflow capacity.

Add controlled software, data, dashboard, automation, research, and technical-documentation capacity while the partner retains the client relationship and approved branding boundaries.

Start with one bounded decision

Qootna begins with a privacy-minimized fit review. A proposal is prepared only after the buyer confirms the current need, owner, access route, budget, acceptance criteria, and delivery constraints.

1. Current need	Define the release, backlog, model, workflow, test environment, or delivery-capacity gap.
2. Authority	Confirm ownership, access, source and data rights, change authority, and end-client restrictions.
3. Acceptance	Agree measurable outputs, reference cases, tests, exclusions, hosting, security, and handover.
4. Commercial packet	Prepare the fixed scope, order form, service terms, delivery plan, and payment handoff for human approval.

What Qootna needs before pricing becomes a proposal

A buyer-confirmed problem, decision owner, approved scope, access and data rights, budget, acceptance tests, hosting and security boundaries, IP terms, conflicts, and delivery location. Market trends and public notices alone remain zero-weight research.

Protected delivery: Qootna can show a bounded approach, acceptance plan, and synthetic or non-sensitive preview before agreement. Source code, credentials, client data, proprietary models, and production access are not released through marketing material.

Global delivery and commercial units

Remote delivery is available globally. Qatar and GCC engagements may use remote or hybrid delivery where agreed. Regulated or licensed work requires opportunity-specific authority and credential evidence before assignment.
